### Installing

Download and run the 'Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0.2' installation file 'setup.exe'. An MSI is available from support by contacting <a href="mailto:support@exclaimer.com">support@exclaimer.com</a>.

### Uninstalling

Uninstall can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' or MSI for the currently installed version of 'Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0' or via 'Add/Remove Programs' in Windows 2003 and Windows XP or 'Programs and Features' in Windows 2008, Windows 2012, Windows Vista, Windows 7 and Windows 8.

The uninstall process will not lose any of your configuration or settings. However as a backup precaution you may wish to export your configuration.

#### **Export Steps**

- 1. Open the Exclaimer Console
- 2. Select the 'Exclaimer' node
- 3. Open the 'Action' menu
- 4. Select 'Export Configuration...'
- 5. Select a location and filename for the export
- 6. Press Save

This will export all your settings including all your templates and licensing data.

#### **Upgrading**

Upgrading can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' which will perform an in-place upgrade.

#### **Fixed Issues**

- Excessive memory usage in the Exclaimer Outlook Settings service.
- Group enumeration not correctly detecting members of a group when the group and members are in different domains.
- Signatures not generated when a non-signature ZIP file was present in the deployment share.
- In certain scenarios the Policy Tester would contain incorrect warnings that an OWA signature template contains local images when using internet images.
- Local copy of images were incorrectly used when a template with internet images was imported.
- When changing 'Deploy signature to' from 'Outlook' to 'OWA' the image options were not updated correctly.
- Policy Tester was unable to determine membership of the Domain Users group.
- Unicode characters were displaying as questions marks when pasted from Notepad.
- An exception was thrown when importing a template that had a {Custom Image} containing a {Field}.
- ExSync did not disregard backslashes used as encoding characters.

- ExSync was not able to create a signature file when the user's display name contained speech marks.
- All template files were saved when saving changes in the console.

### **Changes and Enhancements**

- Improved compatibility with Anti-virus applications.
- Save operation now has a retry strategy to cope with locked files.

#### **Known Issues**

- Unable to determine Share and Security permissions on a DFS namespace share running in Windows Server 2008 mode.
- Security permissions are not applied correctly if the Deployment share is on a DFS namespace on Server 2008 but running in 2000 mode.
